WE are pleased to report that the repairs to the Deer Park drainage are now complete.

The Pavilion is back in use and the puddles have gone! In more good news, works to make the trees safer in all our parks has also come to an end.

We are aware that both projects have caused inconvenience at times for our residents, but the Parish Council is grateful for your patience and understanding.

With works on the drains and trees now ticked off, the Parish Council's 'to do' list, the

focus now moves on to restoring our footpaths. Starting on 19th August, the Deer Park footpath that runs from the back of the Medical Centre to Deer Park School will be closed for repairs.

Our contractor will be raising and resurfacing the path to remove the bumps and cracks caused by tree roots and hopefully keeping it free from flooding.

The works are expected to take no more than two weeks and the path should be open again for the start of the school term.
